

SUSTAINABLE FOREST MANAGEMENT

Common Area 043-20 – Upper Mauricie



The sustainable forest management plan has been developed in accordance with the requirements of Canadian standard CAN/CSA-Z809-02. The applicant seeking to register common area 043-20 according to forest area (DFA), according to the standard, consists of a group of forest companies that obtain timber supplies in the area concerned. These include:

The DFA covered by the sustainable forest management plan consists entirely of public lands managed by the Ministère des Ressources naturelles, de la Faune et des Parcs (Ministry of Natural Resources, Wildlife and Parks). The boundaries of the DFA correspond to the legal boundaries of common area 043-20, as defined in Schedule B of the applicant's timber supply and forest management agreement.

The Advisory Committee for common area 043-20 implemented the participatory process which enabled the identification of sustainable forest management values, objectives, indicators and targets.
