The tour site is at Cook's Marsh on Logger's School Road just west of Corner Brook. The six-hour Tour includes demonstrations on all aspects of the Company's operations. Individual demonstration sites show natural forest regeneration, pre-commercial thinning, waterfowl and wildlife habitat enhancement, road building, pulpwood trucking, as well as conventional and mechanical harvesting systems.

Tours begin at the Human Resources building across from the mill in Corner Brook. After a brief introduction, guests will board buses and head for the woods. Tours are guided by Woodlands employees. The Shriners will serve up a hot lunch at the Cook's marsh waterfowl management area. Reservations are required.
