KRUGER ANNOUNCES PRODUCTION CURTAILMENT AT ITS QUEBEC PAPER MILLS

Montréal (Québec), June 8, 2007 – Kruger announced today that it will proceed to a market-related production curtailment at its Québec paper mills. Coated paper production at the Trois-Rivières mill will be interrupted from June 20 to July 1, 2007 inclusively, and the production of supercalendered papers at the Wayagamack mill will be interrupted from June 9 to June 25 inclusively.

Lastly, Kruger will cease operations temporarily at its three Québec paper mills (Trois-Rivières, Wayagamack and Brompton) during the long weekend of the St. Jean-Baptiste holiday.

These temporary production shutdowns are caused by the combined effects of difficult market conditions and the rising value of the Canadian dollar.

Founded in 1904, Kruger Inc. is a major producer of publication papers, tissue, lumber and other wood products, corrugated cartons from recycled fibers, and green and renewable energy. The Company is also a leader in paper and paperboard recycling in North America. In 2006, the Company acquired the Maison des Futailles, a leading wines and spirits merchant. Kruger operates facilities in Quebec, Ontario, Alberta, British Columbia, Newfoundland and Labrador, in the United States and the United Kingdom and has 10,000 employees.
