KRUGER ANNOUNCES PRODUCTION CURTAILMENT AT TWO OF ITS PUBLICATION PAPERS MILLS

Montréal (Québec), July 13, 2007 – Kruger announced today that it will proceed with a production curtailment at two of its paper mills. The production of one newsprint paper machine at the Corner Brook mill, Newfoundland and Labrador and the production of the super calendered paper machine at the Wayagamack mill, in Trois-Rivières, Québec, will be interrupted effective on July 22, 2007. Combined, these two machines have an annualized production of 145,000 tonnes.

These capacity curtailments are due to the rising value of the Canadian dollar.

Founded in 1904, Kruger Inc. is a major producer of publication papers, tissue, lumber and other wood products, corrugated cartons from recycled fibers, green and renewable energy and wines and spirits. The Company is also a leader in paper and paperboard recycling in North America. Kruger operates facilities in Quebec, Ontario, Alberta, British Columbia, Newfoundland and Labrador, in the United States and the United Kingdom and has 10,000 employees.
