

**Kruger Recycling, Inc.**  
Albany, New York



To meet Kruger Inc.'s rapidly expanding role in recycling and to complement Québec supplies, a United States subsidiary was established to generate baled recyclable paper for use by the company's paper mills in Québec, which produce linerboard and newsprint.



This facility handles paper generated from curbside collection in Albany and surrounding municipalities, thereby reducing the quantity of solid waste sent to landfill. This downward integration gives Kruger Inc. direct control over the recycled paper required to meet its customers' specifications.

Kruger Recycling sorts and bales various grades of waste paper in a 45 000 square foot building. The finished bales are backhauled by Kruger's trucking fleet to the Canadian divisions.

Kruger Recycling also offers recovered paper to the market.
