

Papeles Venezolanos, C.A. ("PAVECA")
Venezuela



Located in Guacara, in the state of Carabobo, Paveca is approximately 100 miles west of Caracas (capital of Venezuela). Founded in 1953, Paveca produces toilet paper, paper towels, napkins, facial tissue and wrapping paper for a total annual converting capacity of 85,000 tonnes/year on nine paper machines.

The site is also equipped with a BCTMP mill capable of producing 35,000 ADMT/year of bleached pulp from its Eucalyptus tree plantation, located 75 miles away in San Carlos.
